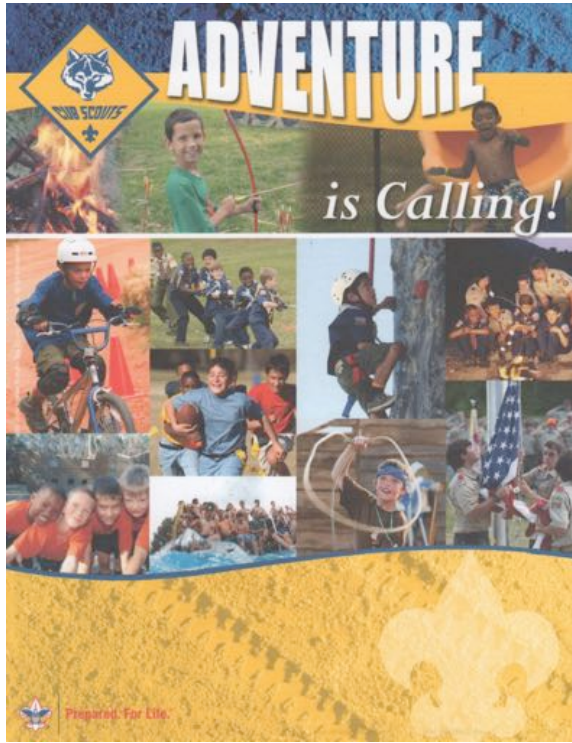
Starting Friday, 9/15, Harvest Festival SignUps will be Online
