For those who would still like to register, we will now be accepting registration forms **until May 14, 2018.** For those who have already registered, you will be contacted to verify your schedule choice.

The OLG Summer Session will be open to incoming K – 6<sup>th</sup> graders. It will include both academic and enrichment courses. Want to help your child maintain what was learned over the school year? Want to keep your child learning fascinating topics over the summer? Sign your child up to join our dynamic staff for the summer. We offer courses that have been designed to help students learn in a happy and safe environment.

## COURSES OFFERED

Each day, the Summer Session is divided into a morning and afternoon schedule. Academics will be covered in the morning while enrichment courses will fill the afternoon. Academic courses in Language Arts and Mathematics will involve reviewing concepts learned over the prior school year. A Religion/Bible Camp will also be offered in the morning.

The enrichment courses will take place in the afternoon after lunch in two, 1-hour sessions with different activities offered. The students will be able to choose which enrichment course they will take each week. Options for the enrichment courses include Sports, Art, Fitness, Baking, Spanish, etc.

## Enrollment for 2018-2019

The enrollment period for our current students is now open thru Tuesday, May 15. Parents should have received an email on May 1 with a link for completing the online enrollment in TADS. Payment of the registration fees is due at the time of enrollment. Please call the school office if you have any questions.

### *Please note:*

- You must be current with financial obligations and have completed the committed service hours for the 2017-2018 school year before enrolling for 2018-2019.
- The enrollment fees did not increase – they are the same as last year:
  - \$410 per student + \$5 per family for PTSG membership
  - Additional fees:
    - First Communion/retreat (grade 2 only): \$50
    - Coloma Outdoor School Camp Deposit (grade 4 only): \$100
    - Science Camp Arroyo Deposit (grade 5 only): \$100
    - CYO Camp Deposit (grade 8 only): \$125
    - Graduation (grade 8 only): \$110
- **A \$25 late fee, per student, will apply if enrollment is not completed by May 15, 2018.**

After completing enrollment, you will be prompted to complete the Tuition Agreement where you choose from several tuition payment options. Payment options have changed. If you choose the 11<sup>th</sup> month payment option, the first payment will be due by June 15, 2018. The full payment discount deadline is July 15, 2018.

Hours earned after 4/13/18 will apply toward next school year.*
