Looking forward to a fabulous Crab Feed in the 70s!!!

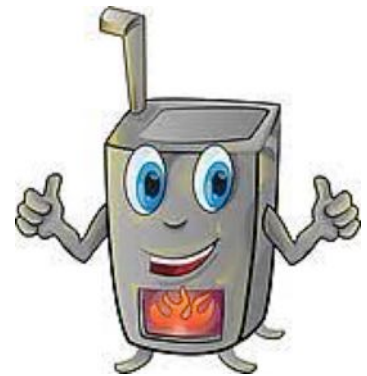
