INSTRUCTIONS FOR CAST FOR FRIDAY, March 29

- Cast and Stage Crew are to be dropped off at Ohlone College Theater on Friday, March 29th between 8:00 and 8:30 am.
- They must check in with Mrs. Bellison in the main lobby.
- The person dropping off must park and escort the child(ren) to the lobby of the theater. No person should enter the theater from one of the backstage doors.
- You will be required purchase a parking ticket at Ohlone's parking lot.
- Snacks will be provided at the theater for the cast and crew.
- Students must return to school on the bus after the performances.
- Lunch will be provided at school for cast and stage crew when students return.
- Each child must be signed out at school should parents wish to take them home early.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CAST FOR SATURDAY, March 30

- Cast and Crew are to be dropped off at Ohlone College Theater at 1:30 PM for the afternoon performance.
- Each student MUST check in at the main lobby area.
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Students MUST be picked up after the first performance at approximately 3:45 PM. For the evening performance, students should be dropped off at Ohlone College Theater at 6:30 PM. Students MUST check in at the main lobby area once again. There will be pizza for cast, crew, and their parents after the evening performance.

This 2019 Summer Session will include both academic and enrichment courses. Want to help your child maintain what was learned over the school year? Want to keep your child learning fascinating topics over the summer? Sign your child up to join our dynamic staff for the summer. We offer courses that have been designed to help students learn in a happy and safe environment.

COURSES OFFERED

Each day, the Summer Session is divided into a morning and afternoon schedule. Academics will be covered in the morning while enrichment courses will fill the afternoon. Academic courses in Language Arts and Mathematics will involve reviewing concepts learned over the prior school year. A Religion/Bible Camp will also be offered in the morning.

The enrichment courses will take place in the afternoon after lunch in two, 1-hour sessions with different activities offered. The students will be able to choose which enrichment course they will take each week. Options for the enrichment courses include Sports, Art, Fitness, Baking, Spanish, etc.
