This year's school photos will be taken by Lifetouch and due to COVID protocols, we will be setting up a specific schedule for student photos, so that only small groups will be present at one time. The date will be announced very soon.

Each family will be receiving an email soon with the scheduled time for your child's/children's photo session which will take place at the Parish Center (the brown building across the parking lot from the school). Please bring your child to the appointment in his/her uniform polo shirt and uniform sweater (not PE sweatshirt).

Unlike previous years, there will be no picture envelope or form required on Photo Day. Those wishing to pre-order photo packages will be able to do so online, and those who do not pre-order photos will be provided with a proof so that they can decide if they want to order photos.
